Volunteers/Helpers

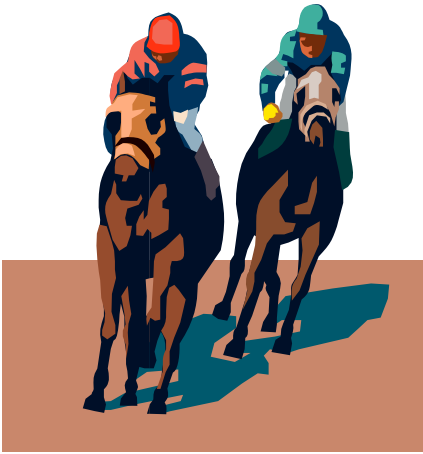
