



**Primary School PE and School Sport Funding for the academic
Year – September 2013 to July 2014**

The funding should be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision. Schools are free to determine how best to use this funding to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision, including increasing participation in PE and sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of.

- Total amount of Primary School PE and Sport Funding = £8,375
- Amount allocated for Financial Year 2013/14 = £5,416
