## Reception Places - September 2024

The online portal is now open for applications for Reception 2024. The closing date for application is **15**<sup>th</sup> **January 2024**. Please be aware that we require additional evidence such as baptismal certificates to accompany your online application. This should be brought to the school office before the closing date in January. Please promote our lovely school with anyone who may be looking for a school place for September.

#### **Dinner Debts**

We are rather concerned about an increasing number of dinner money debts. In January, we will be introducing a new policy and all debts must be cleared promptly. If your circumstances have changed and you feel you may be entitled to **Free School Meals** please contact the school office who can check this out for you. Your child may be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following: Income Support, Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, Income-related Employment and Support Allowance, support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190), Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit, Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

For those pupils currently entitled to Free School Meals we will be issuing vouchers to assist you with providing meals for your child over the Christmas holidays.
