








One book is your child's phonics book. This book has been carefully matched so that it only contains graphemes (written sounds) that your child has been taught previously in their phonics lessons. This to ensure your child can read the book independently. These books are labelled on the back as follows:





The 3.5 refers to the current phonics phase and set your child is working on. Please note, revisit weeks are built into are scheme so the order your child reads their phonics book will not always be sequential.






Some phonics books are matched at an appropriate level but still contain some tricky words. These will be identified in the book by the publisher or by this label, which is Trevor (the tricky word dinosaur). Your child may need help reading these words before beginning reading the book.



Phonics books will be changed once a week. This is to ensure your child can gain confidence and improve their fluency.
